This weekend Jesus continues the challenges we heard in last week's Gospel. He's inviting us to turn the other cheek. When Jesus was in His earthly ministry, being insulted or affronted with a slight or injury was a HUGE DEAL. You had to retaliate for the sake of your honor.

I think the same is true in our day and age, too.

But Jesus invites us to "turn the other cheek," to "give to everyone who asks of you." This is hard! It's an invitation to see our honor, dignity and wealth not in our status and reputation—but in Jesus alone. He's asking us to give us this trust that He will provide for us.

"Give, and gifts will be given to you; a good measure, packed together, shaken down, *and overflowing*, will be poured into your lap." Something for us to consider.

I want us all to think not so much about what "we're giving up" but what we need to receive as a grace from Jesus. By "giving" Him these things, what might be poured into our laps this year?

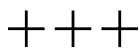
