### LENT WEEK ONE - TILLED.

I want you to imagine you are the new owner of a big patch of land. You survey your land, reaching far over the horizon. It's not lush and green and filled with vegetation, but barren: the dirt is dry and cracked. This land has been forgotten by many.

Just now a man pulls up in a nice red sports car and hollers out the window. "Don't even bother! Nothing will grow there. And you're not even a gardener!"

It's then you realize there's someone beside you. It's Jesus. "Don't listen to Him," Jesus says. "He didn't believe in me either."

"But Lord, he's right," you whimper. "I don't know how to farm. I don't know the first thing about soil. I should just pave over it instead of expecting things to grow."

"I'm not expecting you to produce anything on your own," Jesus says in comfort. "I gave you this land so you and I can grow beautiful things together. Remember the Hebrews who were enslaved? I gave them a land flowing with milk and honey."

You sigh in relief. The fact you don't have to do it alone is comforting. Jesus is smiling, eyebrows raised as if to say, "You in?"

"All right. Let's do it. What's the first step?"

"We have to cultivate the soil. If the seed of faith is to be planted and grow, it needs a seedbed filled with nutrients. All this dry, cracked soil needs to be tilled so oxygen can flow through it. Let's get to work."

You work quietly alongside each other, breaking a sweat and feeling the strain in your back and arms. "Jesus," you cry, "how long is this going to take?" You half expect Him to yell at you, so you brace yourself.

Jesus laughs. "It's going to take a bit of time. But if we keep showing up and try to be faithful, we'll be able to see slow and steady progress. See how we've already rooted out the self-sufficiency, pulled out that negative self-talk, and recognized patterns of sin? We've made a huge dent just by you letting me guide you!"

"I guess you're right. You always are."

Jesus smiles. "Please remember this: I love you and I'm so proud of you. This project isn't a self-improvement plan: it's the path to real peace and joy. You are the field. And I'm so glad to be with you as you grow."

"Thanks, Jesus. It turns out you really are the gardener!"
