From the Desk of Fr. Fallon

There's a moment in every planting where a seed is dropped in the soil. Whether it's a singular seed or a whole row of crops, something is there that wasn't there before.

And as a seed is left in the soil, there's a surrender. The planter has offered the seed to the soil; what will it yield?

The Lord knows what will happen. And He has planted the seed of faith in us. He wants to help us grow good things.

Our theme in this second week of Lent is **PLANTED**. We focused on cultivating last week, making the soil ready for what God can give.

There is a lot of uncertainty in our lives. Will she get better? Will he get the job? Will I make the right decision?

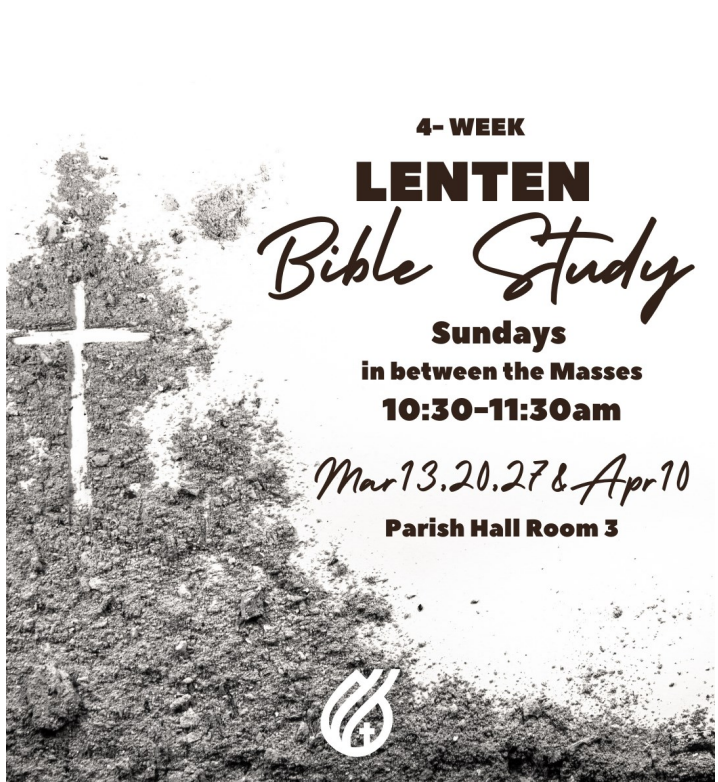
As life keeps happening, we make the decision to nourish the seed of faith, even when we can't see or understand what is growing in us. We keep moving forward with Jesus, even when we don't always understand. This is what faith IS!

In the Gospel today we see Jesus Transfigured in a brilliant white light. There are moments in the faith journey like this, but they are rare. Most of the time we're simply walking around with Jesus, day in and day out, responding to emails and writing bulletin articles. But through our faithfulness we can start to see changes to the little seed in the soil.

It takes time.

“Let Jesus use you without consulting you,” says Mother Teresa. Yikes. But maybe we can come to live this way, to yield great fruit with and for the Lord.
