It's the Fifth Sunday of Lent!

We are It's the fifth Sunday of lent!

This week our focus is on pruning. We need to prune in order to keep growing!

The first time I heard someone talk about pruning I didn't understand it. I thought, "why throw away perfectly good branches?" I came to understand later that by pruning branches and getting rid of excess, you are able to yield longer lasting and more bountiful growth.

The same is true of our spiritual lives. So much of our life is excess; when we trim it back or cut it away we are able to see more beautiful things flower within us.

So what is the excess in your life? What are the things that are attached to you? Are you are attached to them?

By cutting these things away we find freedom we didn't know was there. And by trusting the Lord as He approaches with the garden shears, we can later see things springing forth where other things had been.

Get really practical here: what needs to go? Let's use the final two weeks of Lent to listen to where God wants to prune.


