We're nearing the end of Lent. Today is Palm Sunday, Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem. People laid down palm branches and blankets and coats for the Messiah, proclaiming Him as King.

Strange: a couple of days later they were yelling in the courtyard, "Take Him away! Take Him away! Crucify Him!" (John 19:15).

How quickly they turned their backs on Jesus, sold Him for pieces of silver they could possess. How soon they changed shouts of praise to cries of condemnation.

And how quickly we do the same thing, too.

This isn't the easiest week, because we're invited to participate in the Lord's Passion. Others around us are joyously preparing for Easter, enjoying the Springtime, but we're invited to create times of silence, to enter more fully into penance, to be reconciled as we acknowledge our sin.
