No, this isn't last week's bulletin column. It's still Easter! Jesus' Resurrection can't be contained for a single day, so we celebrate for seven weeks!

*Great... So Father is going to keep dousing us with holy water?*

You betcha! I hope it'll sink in how much God loves you!

This weekend is special, too. It's the time we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday. This is a feast Pope St. John Paul II promulgated to share the revelations of Jesus to St. Faustina in the early 20th Century. In the midst of the bleakness of that time, this Polish religious sister receive visions of Jesus with rays of light coming from His pierced side.

As we talked about on Easter, this isn't a moment that's stuck in time; the Resurrection is a *lived reality*. It's our invitation to live it in our daily lives. Part of that is receiving the mercy Jesus longs to give us.

Not sure how I could talk about Confession more, other than to say that Jesus longs for that mercy to be received specifically in the Sacrament He gives to us.

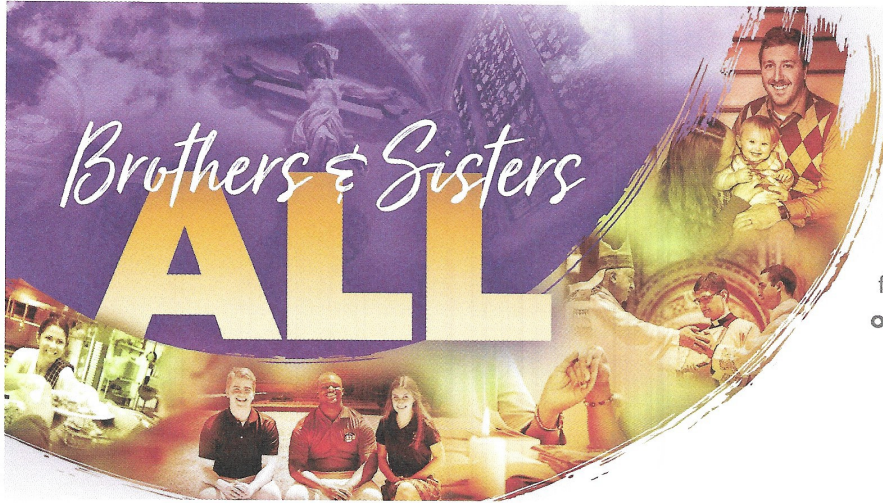
