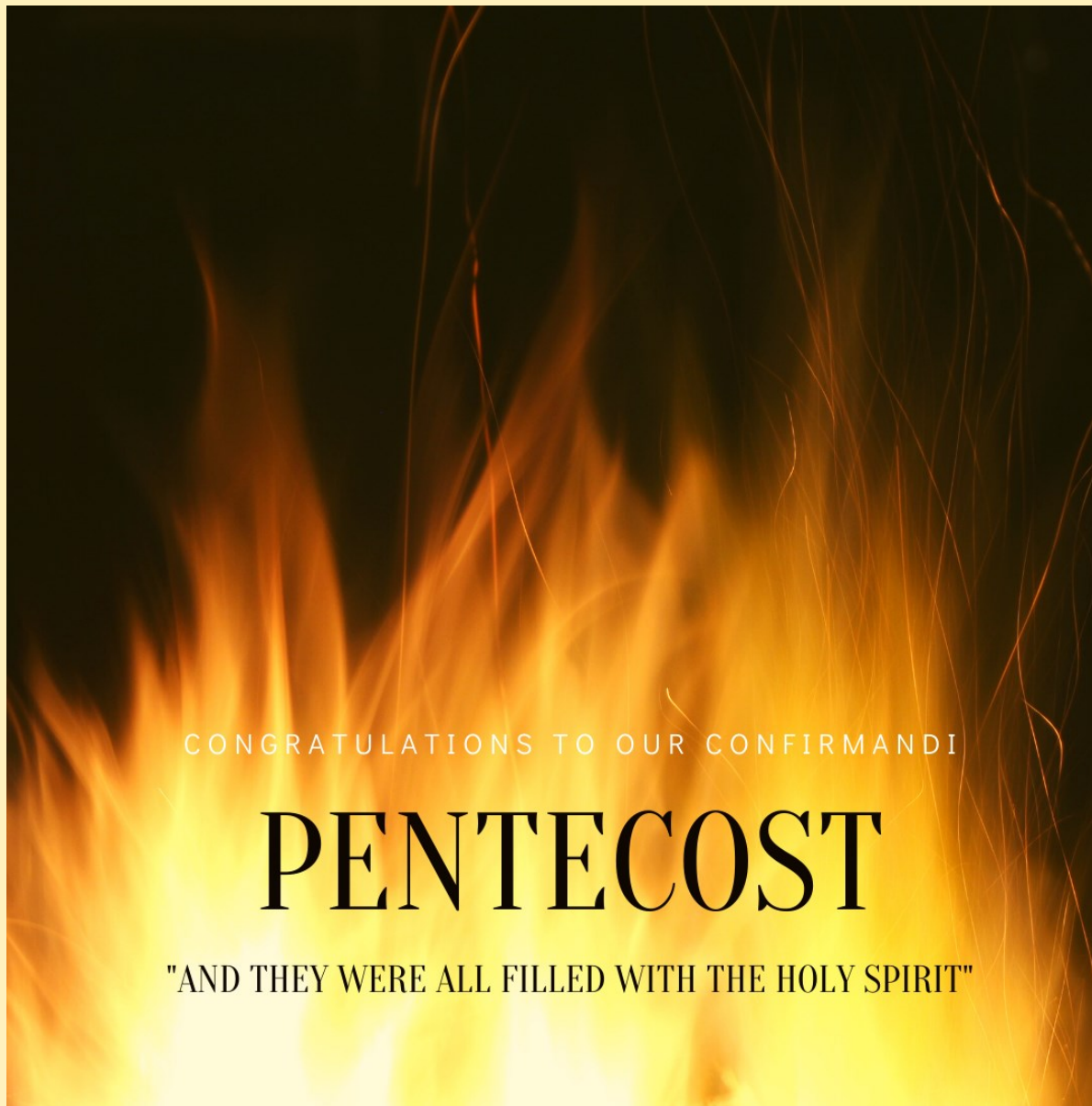

My name is Ali Meehan, and I am thrilled to be stepping into the role of Youth Minister here at Magdalen. I've been a parishioner at Magdalen since October and have loved getting to spend the last several months growing as a part of this community through small groups, Barcia, the Craft Fair, fish fries, and all the many other opportunities that have allowed me to feel so at home so quickly.

As a St. Louis native (growing up in Maryland Heights and attending Cor Jesu Academy), I have always found that my Catholic identity is deeply integrated into my understanding of myself and the world. I graduated from Regis University in 2019 with a BA in English & Religious Studies, and spent the following year as a member of the Jesuit Alum Service Corps, living in community and teaching at Regis Jesuit High School. As this was the year Covid-19 started, I was forced to finish that year of teaching from my computer at my parents' dining room table.

After some significant discernment, I found that I was not yet finished investigating teaching as a possible vocation, and decided to join the Billiken Teaching Corps (another service living program) through which I have spent the last two years earning my MA in Teaching through St. Louis University while teaching full time at St. Mary's High School just up the road from here. While I have loved teaching and St. Mary's in particular, when Fr. Fallon and Jen approached me about applying for the Youth Minister position, it felt like the perfect answer to a question I hadn't even known I was asking.

As Youth Minister, I hope to give the adolescents of our parish and the surrounding communities a place to encounter Jesus authentically and consistently. My own youth group growing up was a central feature of my middle-school and high-school experiences, and I am so excited to have the opportunity to build something of equal importance for the youth of South City.

I ask for your prayers and support over these coming weeks and months. As we are starting from scratch, I am sure I will hit many bumps along the way, but I know with the spirit and prayerful support of this community, we can make a home for South City youth and build a clear path for them from here to the Father.

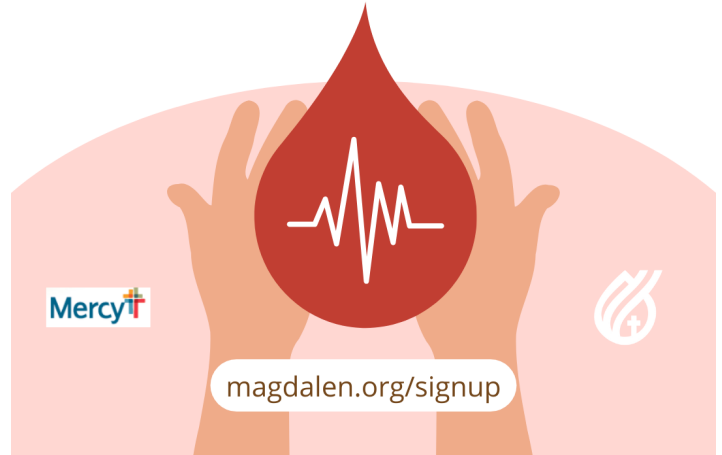
