On top of that, he had started to doubt what he was doing. Is this really God that I'm lifting up at the Consecration? How can bread become God from the words spoken from a sinner like me?

As he set the host down on the paten, it started to bleed. The priest woke up to the fact that "this truly is the Son of God," and invited the others at the Mass to see. They then processed with the Blessed Sacrament, the Eucharist, to the Pope, who then confirmed this to be a Eucharistic Miracle.

This is what we're celebrating today.

What God taught this priest, Peter of Prague, in Bolsena, Italy in 1263, is never to underestimate the power of God. The Lord wants us to remember this, too. God can do whatever, whenever. And if He wants to give us His very self in what looks like bread and wine, He can do that.

And He does! At every Mass! How beautiful!

SO we're going to process around Southampton today to remember that miracle, but also to remind ourselves of the miracle that happens at every Mass when God changes bread and wine into Himself.

How blessed we are!

We're also blessed to celebrate our fathers, living and deceased, who have tried to be signs of God the Father's love for us. Let's pray for our fathers and for many more men to live with hearts for God and their vocations of fatherhood.
