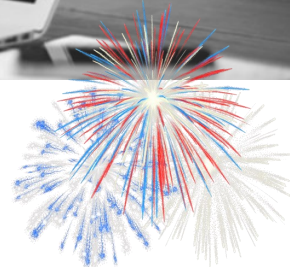

From the Desk of Fr. Fallon

Happy Fourth of July Weekend!

I hope this is a relaxing weekend for you all and that you don't blow up anything besides fireworks. We have a lot to celebrate, a lot of thanksgiving to God for this nation and the freedom it provides.



Following Jesus helps us to experience freedom on a whole other level. Pope St. John Paul II says, "Freedom consists in doing not what we want to do, *but what we ought to do.*"

This quote challenges me—and it challenges our nation's notion of freedom. It's not about getting to do whatever we want, but rather to look about and see what we are called to do, where we can use our energy and gifts to further the freedom given to us.

There are a lot of people that get stuck in the "I'll do what I want" way of living. We all do, at times. But that's not real freedom. In fact, if it's contrary to what God wants, it's sinful, and we're actually not free. We know this well when we see our faith and our laws contradict one another. While we respect everyone's right to freedom, it's our hope they might come to understand the freedom that comes from Christ's fulfilling love.

This is tough to say on the weekend we celebrate our independence, but even the great project of our American society is not the end all, be all. What it can be is a testament to the way we use freedom to serve others.

And that use of freedom is what is inscribed upon Lady Liberty, the poem "New Colossus" by Emma Lazarus:

*Give me your tired, your poor,
Your huddled masses yearning to breathe free,
The wretched refuse of your teeming shore.
Send these, the homeless, tempest-tost to me,
I lift my lamp beside the golden door!*

Let's think of how we at Magdalen can find greater freedom in Jesus, and then serve "the huddled masses yearning to breathe free," in Him.
