Hi Everyone,

This weekend Jen and I are serving on the staff of the Office of Youth Ministry at the Steubenville Youth Conference in Springfield, MO. Thousands of teens will be at Missouri State University this weekend encountering the Lord and learning how to be a disciple. Pray for us!

I'm bummed to miss a chance to preach on the Good Samaritan, so I'll do so a bit here. The line from the scholar of the law in Luke 10 that strikes me the most is, "Because he wished to justify himself." Yikes!

How often do we do things because we wish to justify ourselves before the Lord?

Well, I didn't murder anyone.

I'm on vacation, so I don't have to go to Mass.

I'm not that bad of a person, so I don't need to go to confession.

I raised my kids here and gave a lot of money back then, so ...

Somebody else can do that volunteer job-

It's not my responsibility to evangelize the neighbors.

Yikes!

I've got my own litany, too, when Jesus asks for my whole heart. I justify that I worked really hard this week, or that I just gave him extra time yesterday, or that I'd rather answer those emails and phone calls, because that's for Him, too. Jesus is kind, but He wants us to hear the line before our justification:

"Do THIS, and you will LIVE."

If we're really to be ALIVE in Christ, we need to lay down our whole lives before Him. No justifications! We need to be like the Good Samaritan, who risks his health and his wealth and his most important commodity, *his time*.

We may not see anyone beaten up on the roadside, but we see a lot of people around us, beaten up by the world. Could we spend some time caring for their wounds, providing the salve of Jesus' message of hope? It'll cost you something, sure. But you'll receive far more in return.
