From the Desk of Fr. Fallon

Hi everyone,

We're back in Springfield, MO this weekend for the second Steubenville Youth Conference. This week our youth minister, Ali Meehan, has brought some of our teens down for the conference. Please pray for them and the fruitfulness of our youth ministry program.

How would you like it if you tried to get Jesus to correct someone, and then He turned and corrected you?! That's what happens to Martha in this weekend's Gospel. All she was trying to do was prepare a meal for Jesus and His friends, and then He goes ahead and says she's "anxious and worried about many things."

Fine, Jesus. Give them some food yourselves, Martha could have thought, quoting Jesus to Himself.

As always, Jesus is not wrong. It's not that He is unappreciative of the good service Martha is performing. It's not that He isn't hungry or looking forward to the delicious meal. What He's getting at is how the action is consuming her. She's bitter and frustrated at her sister. She resents that she has to do it by herself.

She's not free because she has taken the work and made it her worth.

There's a lot for us to learn alongside Martha. So many of us have worked hard for the Lord in our varied walks of life, and that's good! But if we start to equate how good we are with what we do, we lose sight of the Lord who wants to restore us to the way He loves us. We don't HAVE to do anything. Having received His love, we respond freely, with out anxiety and worry.

There's a lot of anxiety in our world today. Some of it is clinical; our staff will be happy to speak with you and see if we can help. For all the other types of anxiety, perhaps taking a step back and reflecting on what has you all worked up. Is this something Jesus is trying to heal? Would He rather go without the effort you're making and have you restored to peace? Or, would He rather accompany you in this stress instead of you trying to do it all by your lonesome?

Tough questions to reflect upon, but perhaps this is a good time for us to do so. Think about it.

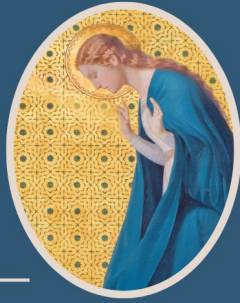
