Good Bye, July!

When the end of this month comes each year I have an itch to go buy school supplies, even though I'm (gratefully) done with academia. There's something neat about new folders and pencils, new sneakers and a whole list of other essentials to start the school year off right.

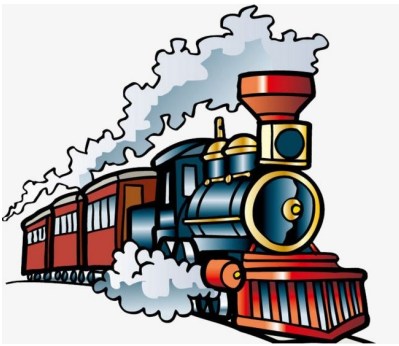
