And many prayers for our educators who have been working hard to get everything ready. We may not see all the behind the scenes work you do, but please know how grateful we are for you! It's a blessing to have so many current and former teachers in our parish (including three principals)!

Thanks for the feedback on our Fall events at Magdalen! We're glad you're excited and appreciate your notice that there's something for everyone. Don't be shy and reach out to someone beyond the pews and invite them to some of our events!

Just to let you in on the method to our ministry here, we're "focusing" on the WIN, BUILD, SEND model of the Fellowship of Catholic University Students, a Catholic campus ministry across the U.S. and worldwide.

A "win" event is where someone comes on campus and sees that this is a warm, inviting place. Maybe they can come to know Jesus here.

A "build" event is where we form people to grow as disciples of Jesus. Think Bible Study, small groups, Adoration & Confession, etc.

A "send" event is when people "go forth" and share the Gospel with their neighbors, family, everyone. We're working our way up to these.

Some of you have proposed other things that we can do. That's great! My encouragement is this: Go for it! Not everything needs to be an official Magdalen event, and not everything needs a "Magdalen Mark on it." If you have an idea, let us know, but don't be surprised when I give you the keys to drive the event. If the Lord is stirring you to do something, He'll give you the grace to see it through.

This is what Jesus is talking about in our Gospel this weekend. He wants the world to be ablaze with His love. Our inclination is to tend to our own fires, but Jesus wants us to come together and set the world ablaze through our witness. This will cause division, sure, but it will also cause us to see we can't stay complacent in where we've been. Jesus is on the move!

Let's ask God how we can best serve Him with the parish He's blessed us with. (Yes, teachers. I ended a sentence with a preposition).
