Hi Everyone,

It's important to mention our memorial of September 11, 2001 this weekend. Let us never forget the lives lost and those who are first responders and our soldiers who fought to defend our freedom. Do you remember where you were, if you can? I thought my high school French teacher was pranking us. How could something like that happen? We must never take our liberty, a gift from God, for granted.

A very special welcome to the seminarian assigned to our parish this year! We're so happy to have Will Young with us from the Diocese of Lafayette, Indiana with us. Will is in his second year of seminary. Please say hello and help Will to feel a part of our happy community. I'm sure we'll experience God's love through this good and holy man!

Speaking of seminary and vocations, I spent the past week at the National Conference of Diocesan Vocation Directors. My other ministry is Vocation Director for the Archdiocese of St. Louis. It was a privilege to meet with my brother vocation directors in Baltimore to learn a little more about our ministry and to pray and spend time in fraternity and support with each other.

One thing I kept hearing over the conference is how we can't presume upon priestly vocations any more. This is an old model, thinking each parish will naturally raise up young men to be our future priests. As one vocation director put it bluntly, "The days of brick and mortar vocations are over."

Priestly vocations are the sign of a vibrant parish. It means the faith has been instilled in the youth of the community, witnessed by the generations prior. Those generations have sought to encourage, not presume, vocations. Parishes have raised up their sons to go and serve the Church, as other families have fostered God's love in their sons—those who have been our parish priests for decades.

When was the last priestly vocation from St. Mary Magdalen?

I say this not as a condemnation but as an encouragement to pray for vocations to the priesthood for St. Louis. This should be among our daily prayers, for we are about to experience the departure of a large number of our aging priests (they're calling it the "Silver Wave").

There are fewer and fewer of us to serve you; please pray for "the Master of the Harvest to send out laborers for his harvest" (Matthew 9:38).
