Hey Fam-

Thanks for the feedback from last week's homily about not having to be "whole" to be holy. I think it's a really important thing to understand, and believe! A relationship with God is the key, letting Him be the one to be with you and help you to become whole. It's about the relationship.

After one of the Masses a parishioner approached me and said, "Ok, but what do I do if I have been trying to be in relationship with God and I don't hear anything from Him? At all."

This is a tough spot. We call it desolation. You show up and try and it feels like you come up with nothing. Why would God not want to be with us, make His presence known?

Sometimes there might be obstacles in our path. What needs to be cleared out so we can hear and see and feel His love more noticeably? The Sacrament of Reconciliation is such a gift—and necessary—to clear that path.

This may be tough to hear, but God also might be stretching you. Relationships all have moments of strain; God wants us to increase our desire for His love, to love Him even if we don't feel good in return. In short, He's teaching us what real love is: an offering of self!

Holiness, then, is receiving a share of God's love. The more we live this way, the more we'll long to let nothing keep us from this wholeness.

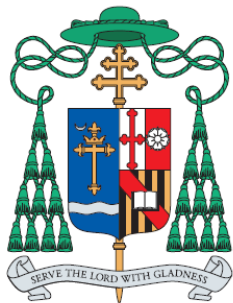

Dear Friends in Christ,

The call to be deacon is to serve. On Sunday, October 2, 2022, there will be a special collection for the formation of permanent deacons in the Archdiocese of St. Louis. This collection relieves some of their financial burden for studies to become a deacon.

Since 1977, 505 men have been ordained as permanent deacons in the Archdiocese. There are 195 active deacons ordained for the Archdiocese and 87 retired deacons. There are 26 men in formation at this time.

When the permanent diaconate program was initiated in the Archdiocese in January 1977, men went through a two-year formation program, with a third year of post-ordination formation. Since then, the program has gradually expanded to five years of formation, plus five more years of post-ordination formation.

Deacons serve in parishes, hospitals, archdiocesan agencies, and other organizations. They offer their time, talent and energy to strengthen our church in St. Louis and do not receive compensation for their work. Their service extends into many areas of parish life, including the proclamation of the Gospel, liturgical functions, administration, and charitable works. Many active deacons continue to be employed full-time, requiring them to balance family lives and professions with their ministry as a deacon.
