I wanted to take this opportunity to give some updates about the Youth Ministry program here at Magdalen (MYM). We have officially been up and running for two full months, and we are very excited about everything we have been able to do so far.

The process of launching a brand new youth ministry program has been fairly challenging. The first several steps went extremely well. I spent the summer months recruiting a phenomenal team of adult leaders who are now dedicating multiple hours each week to working with our teens and planning various talks and activities. However, after visiting multiple high schools in our area and getting very little response in the way of new teens, I realized that the types of outreach I was familiar and comfortable with were not going to be sufficient, so we started over.


By asking the question, "Who needs help?" — we were able to identify a whole community of ESL (English as a second language) families in need of assistance. We have since started offering an hour of homework help and a communal meal before our Thursday night faith formation. As a result, we have been able to reach a group of Catholic families who were previously inaccessible to us. Parents who, due to a language barrier or other concerns, struggle to help their teens with homework have been able to support their students' academic success as well as their developing faith lives just by dropping them off with us once a week.

In addition to the great success of our Homework Help program, I wanted to touch on The Well briefly. The Well is MYM's monthly evening of Adoration with praise & worship music. We have had an amazing turn out at our first two Wells and hope to have more of you join us in the future. If you are interested in attending, our next two Wells will be on 11/17 and 12/15. This month we are excited to welcome Br. Jacob Mazur-Batistoni of the Dominican Friars as our speaker and the December Well will double as our Advent evening of prayer.

If you are feeling called to assist in this ministry, there are a variety of opportunities to do so. We could use one more person willing to pick up food on Sundays once a month, ideally first Sundays. We would also welcome anyone who might be interested in cooking or financially sponsoring any of our Thursday Homework Help meals or helping out with our semi-regular, thematic decorations in the MYM meeting space. If any of these opportunities are of interest to you or you have any other ideas for how you might like to aid the MYM ministry, I would love to speak with you.
