Happy 4th Sunday of Ordinary Time!

In today's Gospel, we hear one of the most beloved passages of scripture: The Beatitudes. The Beatitudes are familiar to us. We might even have heard them so many times over the course of our lives that we struggle to find any kind of new meaning in them, just repeating the same words without looking deeper.

In the Foundations of Catholic Morality course I am taking this semester at the Aquinas Institute, the professor began the class by pointing us to two of the most important Biblical teachings on morality: The Ten Commandments and the Beatitudes. In reflecting on these two sets of teachings side-by-side like this, I was struck by how much more usable I find the Ten Commandments to be in my prayer life. Don't lie. Don't steal. These are pretty clear instructions. If I do an examination of conscience, I know quite clearly when I have done well and when I have failed.

The Beatitudes on the other hand can be a bit more difficult. Have I been humble? Have I been meek? Do I thirst for right-eousness? These questions can be harder to answer because they involve actually behaving in a particular way rather than just avoiding specific actions. Even when I begin to say, "yes, I have been humble," I immediately start to wonder whether this might be a form of pride I am taking in having humility. It's much more difficult for me to look for the good things I have done in my week than to find all my faults. And I think this is probably a shared experience.

For this reason, I urge you to take the Beatitudes to prayer this week. Take some time to examine your conscience (maybe on Wednesday at Adoration when confession is available), not in the way that I usually fall into with a checklist of all the bad things I have done recently, but by working your way through the Beatitudes. And don't skip the second half of the lines! When you ask yourself whether you have shown mercy to others, don't forget to look for the times you yourself have been shown mercy. When you look for what you have to mourn and the sacrifices you have made, make sure you also take time to notice the people and things that have been a comfort to you. Jesus knew what he was talking about when he handed these instructions on to his Apostles, and since they have been handed on to us, we should remember to use them as the map they are, directing our steps closer to the Lord each day.




