Hi everyone! So what are you giving up for Lent?

How about we give up (or take on) whatever will help us love more like Jesus by Easter? At the heart of our three pillars of Lent - prayer, fasting, and almsgiving - is love. Why else would we ever sacrifice our time, comforts, or money if we didn't love someone other than ourselves?

And wouldn't you know it, love gushes forth from Scripture. Our First Reading (Lev 19:18) "Love your neighbor as yourself" sure seems to be in perfect alignment with our Gospel (Mt 5) as Jesus offers us a litany of ways to love: turn the other cheek, give to the one who asks of you, love your enemies, and pray for those who persecute you.

Love is meant to be at the heart of our sacrifice. As my coffee mug reminds me, "Let us love, since that is what our hearts were made for!" (St. Thérèse of Lisieux) So as long as we keep our eyes on Love, we'll find an abundance of grace through our Lenten promises instead of just empty space. When I give up chocolate or swearing or gossip, what fills that gap in my life? Lord, let it be You! Let it be love!

One of the things I find myself saying over and over again in counseling is: listen to the people who love you. Because the people who love us want for our best good; they don't just want something from us. We love you here at Magdalen and would love to walk with you this Lent. I'm particularly excited about Lenten Letters and our Young Adult Bootcamp. And the Lenten Bible Study. And the hush puppies at the Fish Fry. Okay, I am full of excitement (what else is new?). But also full of love. May the Lord perfect His love in us as we begin our journey through Lent together.






