Hi, everyone!

I love to celebrate. I put up six or seven Christmas trees every year. Candy hearts take over in February. Pumpkin spice fills every nook and cranny of the fall like the Magdalen's broken alabaster jar of aromatic nard. And my house basically transforms into Ireland for St. Patrick's Day. (My dad bequeathed me a leprechaun the size of a fourth grader that occasionally makes me jump and think someone has broken into my house.)

I think this is why I love Lent so much: the intensity of preparation for the upcoming celebration! I love the minor chord progressions in the music. I love the sensory experiences of our liturgies: ashes on the forehead, that moment of confusion when I'm expecting the Gloria or Alleluia before I remember it's Lent (every time!), covering the statues on the Fifth Week of Lent, waving palm branches on Palm Sunday, washing feet on Holy Thursday, kissing the Cross on Good Friday, the fire and light at Easter Vigil!


I love how it's so different from the other seasons of life. I love how its very austerity tries to get inside every aspect of my life: give something up, take something on, give something away. It's like climbing up a mountain with Jesus and seeing Him transfigured before me...and wanting to joyfully set up three amazing tents, only to hear Jesus speak directly to me: not yet.

Ha! Okay, so I don't ever love hearing "not yet." And I certainly don't love daily bread, as I would have most certainly tried to add preservatives to the manna in the desert "just in case." But where would I be without the Lord's gentle, but firm reprimands? Like a good Father, God is teaching me. Because Jesus didn't go up to that mountain top alone that day; He brought with him Peter, James, and John. He brought us with Him there today as we heard the story proclaimed in the Gospel. Jesus didn't come to earth to be transfigured just cuz He could, and it's pretty awesome. No, Jesus wants to take us with Him!

In fact, I think Jesus wants us to be transfigured, too. Why else would we read this passage during Lent? Oh that our Lenten practices- abstinence, devotions, almsgiving- might transfigure us to become more like Jesus! What a cause for celebration that would be! Yes!!! I'll toast a Cadbury egg to that.



- Drove multiple homebound parishioners to the Doctor.




