

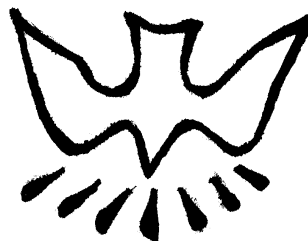

A REFLECTION ON PENTECOST

For Christians Pentecost is a memorial of the day the Holy Spirit descended on the apostles and the Virgin Mary in the form of fiery tongues, an event that took place fifty days after the Resurrection of Jesus. The Paschal Mystery culminates in the sending of the Holy Spirit by the Father on Jesus' disciples. The feast also commemorates the official inauguration of the Christian Church. The main theme of today's readings is that the gift of the Holy Spirit is something to be shared with others. They remind us that the gift of the Holy Spirit moves its recipients to action. "Come, Holy Ghost, Creator blessed, and in our hearts take up Thy rest!"

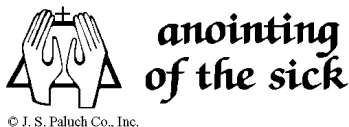
We served 171 guests at the May meal. The date for our next meal is **Tuesday, June 18.**
