From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners and Friends,
 Each year we are asked to have a representative of a missionary order make an appeal as part of the Archdiocesan Missionary Plan of Cooperation. This takes place in all of the parishes throughout the Archdiocese. This year the Missionary Sisters Servants of the Holy Spirit are asking us to make the appeal on their behalf. They have sent us information to share with you. Because of the amount of information sent to us I thought it would be best to break it up over the next two weekends.

The community Province Center of the Holy Spirit Missionary Sisters is in Northfield, Illinois (just north of Chicago). The congregation numbers about 3,100 sisters world-wide, living and working in international/inter-cultural communities in 49 countries.

The focus of their ministry is women and children, working especially with the poor and marginalized through healthcare, education, catechesis, and socio-pastoral service. Most importantly they aim to be a "Face of God" among those whose life circumstances make it difficult to know and believe in God's love for them.

Christ's mission on earth was to show the world the love, compassion and mercy of the Father. Our mission is to respond to the call of our baptism and follow the Way of Christ. In the words of Sister Mary Miller, "Missionary is not about who we are (priest, sister, brother, layperson...) or where we go. It is about how we are and how we are in our daily lives - how we share God's love to others."

"Each one of us has the potential to be an 'image of God,' a 'stained glass window' through which God's love is reflected in seemingly insignificant gestures of kindness and courtesy, a smile, a helping hand, a listening ear to one who is lonely, in pain, suffering; when we speak up for the voiceless, when we share our abundance with those who lack the necessities of life, when we pray with the sorrowing and rejoice with the happy! In our moment of encounter with others (family, friends, strangers), the presence of God is made visible through us."

Today, we think about and pray for those who have chosen to dedicate their lives in service to the

Church; who have chosen to be available to go beyond what is familiar and comfortable, to witness God's love and mercy.

During the course of this week let us reflect upon Sister's words above and pray for the work of these Sisters and all missionaries throughout the world. They are a visible extension of our own love and concern for the poor. Next week I will continue their story, share examples of their work, and ask that you be generous once again in response to their appeal.
