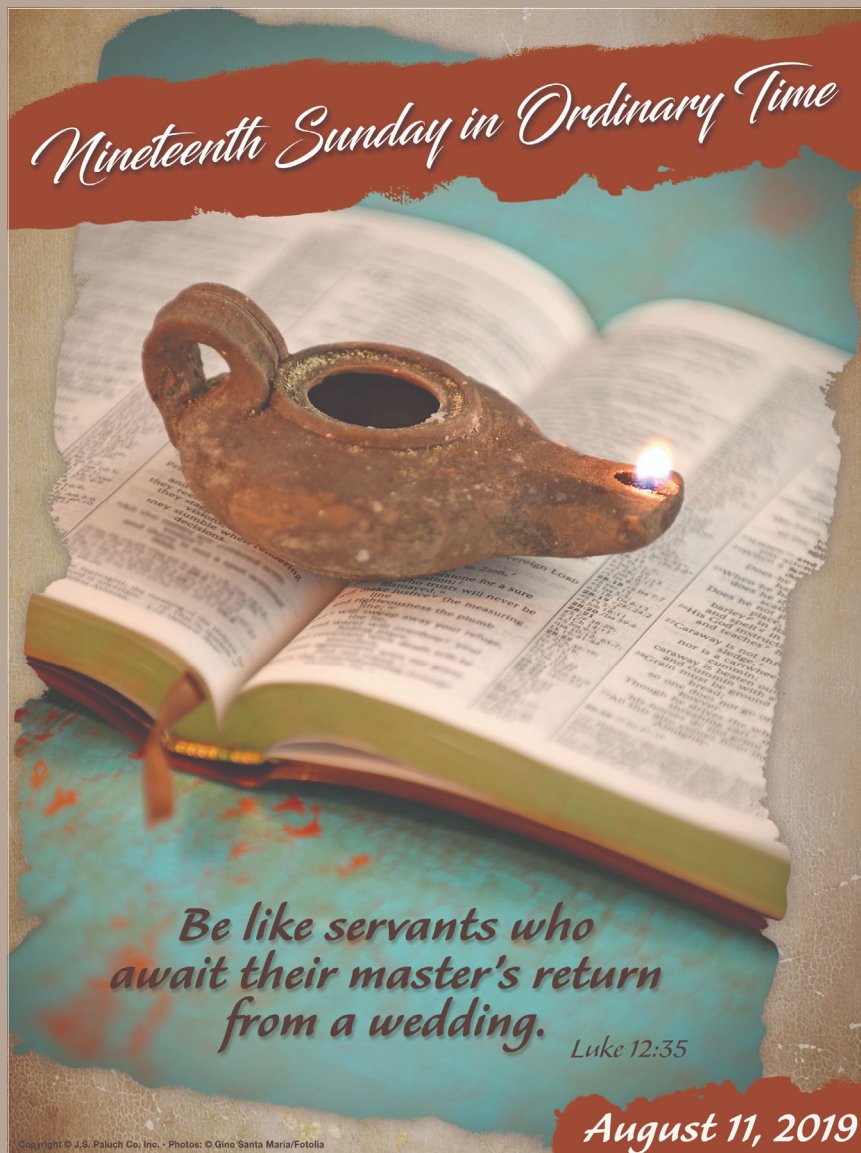

Dear Parishioners and Friends,
As we prepare for our final celebrations for the 100th anniversary of St. Mary Magdalen Parish, we need to

begin to bring everything to completion. Please be mindful of the following.

Dinner reservations and Bus transportation reservations for the dinner at the Cedars will continue to be accepted during this coming week. The Cedars needs to have our final count by August 19th. Revised seating assignments will be made and a finalized list will be sent to the Cedars. After that, no additional reservations will be able to be accepted.

We will continue to take orders for Pavers. There is no deadline for these orders. However, all paver orders received from this point on will not be able to be included in the initial creation of the paver walk but will be added sometime after the Centennial celebrations.

We will also continue to take orders for the Centennial Memory Book. Completion of the books will take place after the Dinner at the Cedars and the Closing Centennial Mass with Archbishop Carlson so that pictures of these last two events can be included in the book. No specific date has been given for completion of the publication of the book but we anticipate that it will be available sometime in December.

The closing Mass of our centennial will take place at 4:30pm on Saturday, September 14, 2019. Principal celebrant and homilist will be Archbishop Robert Carlson. Music for this Mass will be provided by Father Bruce Forman and the Young Catholic Musicians. We invite all parishioners, former parishioners, and alumni to be in attendance.

Guest books will be available throughout the church to be signed by all who are in attendance. Pages of the guest books will be compiled in order to create one large book, dated September 14, 2019. This book then will be placed in the parish Archives for future reference in the next century.

For the convenience of those unable to attend Mass on Saturday evening, and for guests from other parishes, there will be one Mass celebrated on Sunday, September 15th. That Mass will be celebrated at 9:30am. No other Mass will be celebrated on that Sunday.

Pavers

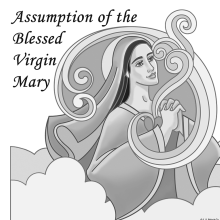
